Drug and Alcohol Policy

Children's Aid Society strives to act in the best interest, welfare and safety of the children placed in our care. Children's Aid Society is a Mandated Child Abuse reporting agency and is bound by the laws of the State of Pennsylvania.

In the event a parent, guardian or designated person should come to Children's Aid Society Child Care and appears to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol, we reserve the right to contact another adult on the child's emergency contact list to come and pick-up the child. This action may be taken even though there is some question as to whether the person is under the influence / impaired to any degree. Although we cannot bar a guardian from taking a child, we also reserve the right to notify authorities.

If the person that appears to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol is with another unaffected adult, we reserve the right to assure that the unaffected adult is driving.
